The Ten Commandments

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ABSTRACT

Moral values and graciousness, in the past, were prominent in most teenagers. Majority of the youths then learnt respect, courtesy, consideration, decency, propriety, honesty and righteousness from a young age, and had enough self-discipline to hold to these values. However, these moral values and self-discipline are slowly diminishing. Over the years, almost all of the younger generation are gradually disregarding these ethics. The listed values have slowly faded away, as they mean little to these adolescents, as moral values and self-discipline are on the verge of disappearing.

We are facing the lack of morality nowadays. Everywhere we look, we can see crimes, rapes, drugs, violence, stealing, murdering, sheating- a plenty of immorality. It seems people lost their moral compass and there are more and more who are wandering in the moral darkness. Especially problematic group are young people. This is the point I will highlight in this essay, and I will try to explain why youngs often choose the wrong way and is there any possibility to prevent this.

REZIME

Moralne vrednosti i ljubaznost su bile prisutne kod većeg dela tinejdžera u prošlosti. Morality is a personal or social set of standards for good or bad behavior and character, or the quality of being right, honest or acceptable. It is characteristically the way you make decisions based on what you think is right or wrong. However, this warning seems to be considered a fraud because the number of people who subscribe to these laws seem to diminish every day. This, therefore, gives reason to my opinion that Christian morality is having a tough time surviving due to its leniency.


Religion has many functions within a society, both social and psychological. It appears to do this by encouraging what a given society deems acceptable behavior and discouraging socially inappropriate behavior. Every religion, regardless of the form it takes, is an ethical system that prescribes proper way of behaving. This social order of rewards and punishment is reinforced when backed by supernatural authority. Thus one's neighbor may be exorcized from his or her community when a behavior is seen as socially unacceptable or inappropriate. Examples of this in the Christian community would be the breaking of the Ten Commandments such as stealing, committing adultery, or murdering.

Try to read these ten laws carefully and ask yourself, what are they actually? Are they moral laws or religion ones? Or both? If you think they are only religion laws, then imagine how the world would look like if only believers in God had obeyed these laws.

- 1. Do not have other gods before God.
- 2. Do not make idols.
- 3. Do not take the name of God in vain.
- 4. Keep the Sabbath day Holy.
- 5. Honor your parents.
- 6. Do not kill.
- 7. Do not commit adultery.
- 8. Do not steal.
- 9. Do not bear false witness against your neighbor.
- 10. Do not covet your neighbour's possessions.

These are the Ten Commandments, the ten laws in the Bible that God gave to the nation of Israel shortly after the exodus from Egypt. Tertullian, an early Christian writer, asserted that the Ten Commandments were engraven on the hearts of men even before being written on the tables of stone. But over time it changed. People forgot the basic moral values and God once again reminded people that they must follow some rules in order not to get lost

in a world of sin and become what they shouldn't be. Because of this, God gave to Moses the Ten Commandments engraved on two stone table on Sinai Mount. The commandments that God gave Moses were not to be only followed by the people of Israel, but they are commandments for all people. They not only applied to those that lived




before Jesus but also apply to us who came after Jesus' life on earth. But, many people today feel that God's Ten Commandments are no longer valid because they do not apply to our current society. They look to the Ten Commandments as being outdated and full of inflammatory language which does not sit well with our politically-correct viewpoint. Does this mean we can all have lovers, kill or steal because some rules are not valid anymore? These fundamental rules have been around since the Old Testament and are still expected to be obeyed. 
Teaching moral (or character) values to children in school, from an early age, will enable them to achieve greater success in all areas of life. By discussing and educating

Teenagers and other minor individuals commit crime and participate in gang violence which causes society to become a dangerous and insecure place to live in. Also, experiences in high school prove several students and classmates abuse drugs and smoke cigarettes on the school campus. Fellow classmates and students roam around the school smoking cigarettes and abusing drugs in the locker rooms and bathrooms. By analyzing readings on teenage pregnancy, observations on juvenile crime and gang violence, along with experiences in high school, one can comprehend that schools should help students understand moral choices and social issues.




The best known Commandments






What we can see from these statistics is that the best known commandments are 5th, 6th, 8th and 9th. That does not mean that other ones are not important. In my opinion, to honor our parents is equally important because we cannot respect other people when we do not respect the members of our own family, our father and mother who brought us into this world and gave us the most precious thing we have, our life. Also, nothing less important is not to commit adultery. To people we love we must give some sacrifices and try not to make them suffer because of us. But, it is not important which or how many commandments we know, it is essential to follow them. The best indicator are the opinion and experience of the people who took part in this survey.






